

Matching Game

First, print the cards on cardstock (the last page of this file is side #2 of the cards) and the game instructions on plain paper. **Second**, cut out the game label on the dotted lines and glue it on the outside of a letter-sized envelope. **Third**, cut out the instructions and the cards, and store them in the envelope when you are finished playing.

How To Play The Matching Game

Set Up The Game: Shuffle the cards and lay out the cards face down in rows.

Play: Player #1 chooses two cards and turns them over. If the two cards are a matching pair, then the player takes the two cards. Player #1 plays until he/she does not make a match.

If the cards are not a match they are turned back over and it is now Player #2's turn. The players continue taking turns until all the cards are played.

How to Win: Collect the most matching pairs.
