European Geography & Cultures Class

Second – Fourth Grade **Italy, Greece and Bulgaria**

If you would like to teach **Greece** in a separate lesson, some suggestions are provided below. We ran out of weeks in our coop!

A. Introduction to Italy, Greece and Bulgaria

1. Read

- Galloping the Globe, page 81
- A to Z Italy (The images in the PDF file provided in the related blog post and my sample cards are based on this book.)
- Greece (True Books: Countries) or Greece (A to Z)
- <u>Children Just Like Me</u> page 32

2. Map Folders and Stamp Albums

- Pass out Folders and Stamp Albums.
- Pass out postage stamps from Italy, Greece, Bulgaria, San Marino, Monaco, and Vatican City and stamp hinges.

B. Physical Geography of Italy, Greece, and Bulgaria

1. Where on Earth

- **Find** the continent of Europe and the countries of Italy, Greece, Bulgaria, San Marino, Monaco, and Vatican City on a globe. Have students color these countries on the map on their folder.
- **Find** Europe and these three countries in the Atlas: start on page 76 of Where on Earth? Atlas, then find the country on page 78. Move on to page 80 to view the landscape, and to page 94 to see it by night.

2. Climate, Population and Wildlife

- **Review** Europe's overall climate on page 90 of Where on Earth? Atlas.
- To see pictures of some of the animals living in the Italy **visit** http://www.essentialitaly.co.uk/blog/beautiful-wild-animals-italy/
- **Read** pages 60 61 of the <u>DK Children's Atlas</u> about Italy, then read pages 66 67 about Bulgaria and Greece. **Find out** about **agricultural** products, major **landforms**, and **water** bodies.

 - **Listen** to *Around the World Stories* from Italy or Greece while working (subscription required: https://www.aroundtheworldstories.com/).
 - Flag and Map Country Cover Card PDF File
 - Country **Information** Card PDF File
 - **Category** Cards plain index cards or pre-printed PDF File (you may want to provide samples for students to copy)
 - Images PDF File for Category Cards
