A. Introduction to the Spain and Portugal

1. Read

- Galloping the Globe page 107
- Spain: A Benjamin Blog (The images in the PDF file provided in the related blog post and my sample cards are based on this book.)
- Children Just Like Me page 33

2. Map Folders and Stamp Albums

- Pass out Folders and Stamp Albums.
- Pass out postage stamps from Spain and Portugal, and stamp hinges.

B. Physical Geography of the British Isles

1. Where on Earth?

- **Find** the continent of Europe and the countries of Spain and Portugal on a globe. Have students color these two countries on the map on their folder.
- **Find** Europe and these countries in the Atlas: start on page 76 of <u>Where on Earth? Atlas</u>, then find the countries on page 78. Move on to page 80 to view the landscape, and to page 94 to see it by night.

2. Climate, Population and Wildlife

- **Review** Europe's overall climate on page 90 of Where on Earth? Atlas.
- **Review** page 92 of <u>Where on Earth? Atlas</u> to see the **wildlife** common across Europe, and don't miss the "**Biomes**" sidebar.
- **Read** page 58 59 of the <u>DK Children's Atlas</u> about Spain and Portugal. **Find out** about **agricultural** products, major **landforms**, and **water** bodies.

 - **Listen** to *Around the World Stories* from Spain or Portugal while working (subscription required: https://www.aroundtheworldstories.com).
 - Flag and Map Country Cover Card PDF File
 - Country **Information** Card PDF File
