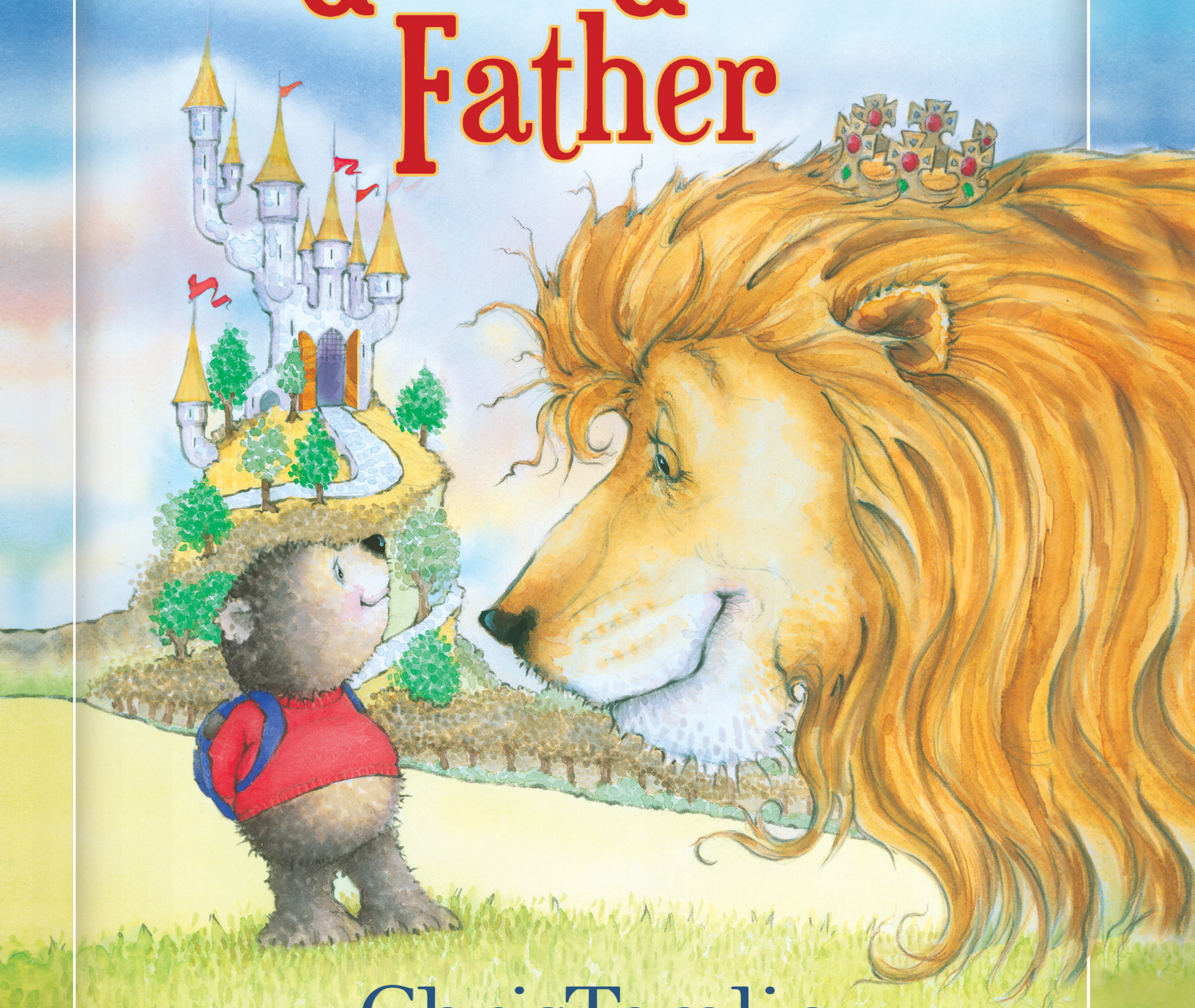

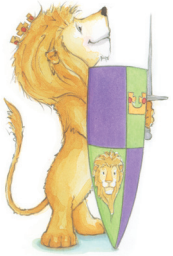

Good Good Father Family Conversation Starters

What do you like most about the story of Tucker and the King in *Good Good Father*?

Tucker went to see the King because he noticed his friends were having a hard time. Do you have any friends who are having a tough time? What are some ways you can help them?

In the story, Tucker learned that the King lives in a castle where the door is always open. Why do you think the King's door is always open?

Tucker visited several animal towns before he got to the King's castle. Which was your favorite town, and why?

Do you remember some of the things Tucker learned about the King on his journey to the castle? (*Parental hint: the King is a warrior, a teacher, a doctor, a farmer, and a musician; talk about how your family sees God in these ways.*)

What feelings does Tucker experience throughout the book? Describe a time when you felt that way.

The King said Tucker was his perfect gift. Why is Tucker the King's perfect gift? And why are you God's perfect gift?

God loves you more than anything or anyone in the whole universe! What are some of the ways you know that God loves you? (*Parental hint: be ready to share some of the ways you know God loves you to help lead this discussion along.*)

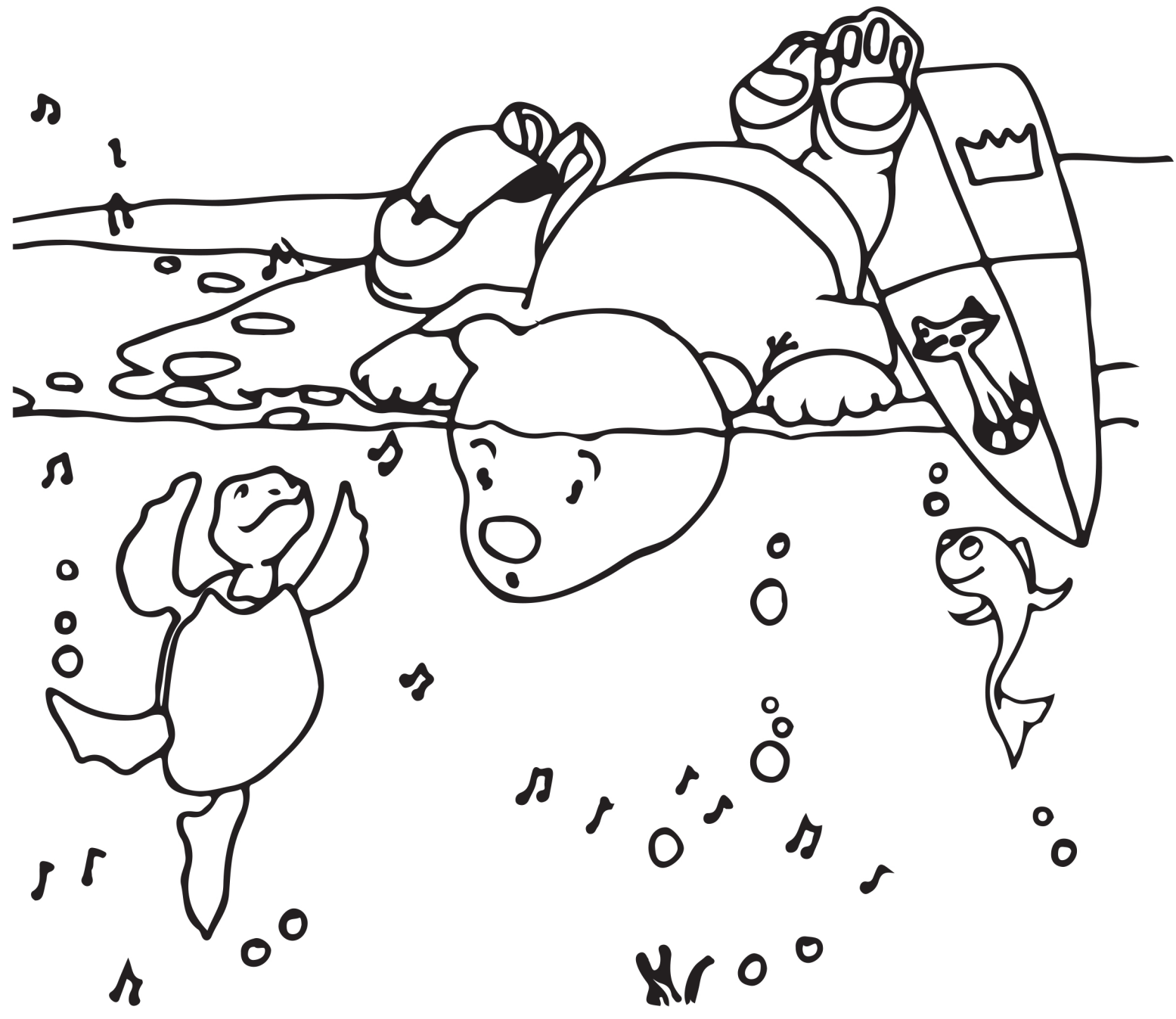

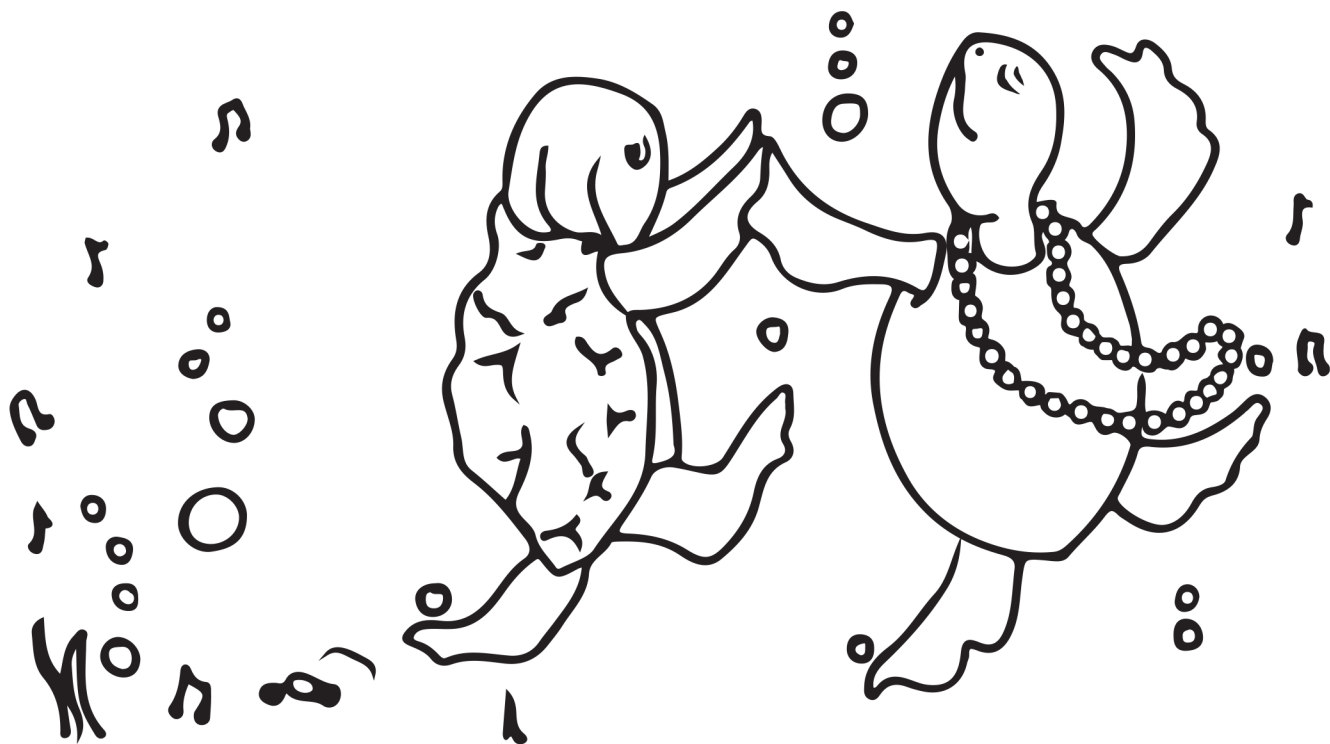
